Dear Trosper Member:

Well, it's almost 2003 and time to get ready for the Trosper Archery Club leagues and shooting season. Your new officers have been elected, the Safety Code has been updated, and the Bylaws have been amended to reflect changes in the Club. Copies of these, along with your renewal form and the 2003 Shoot Schedule are included for you in this mailing.

Please take a moment to fill in both sides of the renewal form with your updated information, write a check for your type of membership and place it in the envelope we have provided for you with Treasurer Jane Johnson's address ready to mail.

Our goal this year is to reach at least 100 members. Last year we had 80 members and their families, up quite a few from recent years.

The officers and members have talked quite a bit about the needs of the Club and what our membership wants and we have set a few new priorities. Reviews of who shoots when indicate that we do very well with members shooting indoor and outdoor leagues, and members have shown quite a bit of interest in field and target shoots. We have added more of these into the 2003 schedule.

We also plan to offer help sessions and instruction to members who desire assistance and have counted a growing number of youths with interest in archery. Recognizing that the future of archery is dependent upon more young people shooting, the Club will increase its youth programs during 2003.


Two other changes must be mentioned in this letter: first is the reinstated requirement for all "Participating Members" to keep and fill out the enclosed card for hours spent helping the Club. The second item is to make certain that you understand that the dues have been increased (by only about \$2 a month) to cover increased expenses and to provide better targets during 2003 and the coming years. In fact, we are actively trying to purchase new 3D targets from another club that is closing so that our target inventory stays interesting and in good repair.

The secret to Trosper Archery Club's success will be the total number of members and the involvement of those members. The Club is on an upward spiral right now and 2003 looks like a year to grow and improve. Jane Johnson signed up our first new 2003 member today and now we have only 99 more to go.
